We are happy to welcome you to our upcoming Holistic Festival which will be held on Sunday, March 30, 2008 at Centerplace in Mirabeau Point Park. We have been looking for a new home for some time now. We are hopeful that this new location will be a positive step and meet everyone's needs. The facility is beautiful, as is the scenery seen through the windows. The location is central to Spokane and Coeur d'Alene. It's just a few minutes from the Pines exit on the freeway, near The Valley Mall.

As per our usual policy, we will be limiting the amount of any one type of booth, resulting in our turning away potential vendors after the available slots for that type of booth have been filled. We will not make exceptions by adding more of any type of venue because you did not respond in a timely manner. Also, the space is slightly smaller than we've had in the past. Once we are filled, we will need to decline additional vendors. We will not have the flexibility to add spaces at the last minute. Reserve your space early!

Again, we will be offering free lectures throughout the event. We will do our best to have a diverse presentation to draw public interest. Remember, these lectures are offered to teach the public about something, not to give a half-hour sales pitch. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee a lecture spot for every vendor, as we have only one lecture offered at a time, so there is not time for everyone. However, do trust that those interested in what you have to offer will visit you at your booth to learn what you have to say! As always, we will advertise the lecture schedule in the Inlander, as well as on this website, and will hand out the schedule to all attendees as they enter the Festival.

We will be doing our usual advertising, and trust that you all will assist the Festivals' success by participating in the distribution of postcards and posting flyers wherever you can. Word of mouth is the most valuable advertising available. If you will, please carry postcards and flyers in your car and brief case, and hand them out at every opportunity. It is surprising how many people you will reach by doing that. If each booth holder attracts only 12 friends and clients, that will bring in 500 people. Of course, we'll continue to spread the word through media advertising in North-East and South-East Washington, Idaho and Montana.

We increase our mailing list - as well as put a smile into someone's life - by offering a free drawing at the Festival. We ask that vendors donate a gift to put into the basket for the lucky winner. Thank you in advance, for your contribution.

We are asking that everyone co-operates with the overall spirit of the Fest by charging for services provided. It creates hardships if one booth is giving away the same service that another booth is charging a fee to receive. We recommend a minimum of \$1 per minute for services rendered.

We also encourage everyone to read the contract carefully, as its purpose is to create a win-win situation. All the details regarding the Fest are to be found in the Contract. Please read it.

Enclosed you will find an application and contract. Please complete them both and return with your payment. We will not reserve booth space until payment is received. *Your envelope should include 3 things: Contract, Application and Check (made out to Sybil Vaughn), also a Lecture Application if desired.*

Also, a 6 foot table will fit across the entire front of the booth – therefore, if you want the public to enter the booth, the table must sit sideways inside the booth, or you need to bring your own, smaller table to go across the front of the booth or you need to order a larger booth.
- 8' wide x 8' deep = \$190 if payment received by March 15, \$215 if paid after March 15
- Premium booth 8' wide x 8' deep = \$235 if payment received by March 15, \$260 if paid after March 15
This booth comes with two 8 foot tables & is in a premium location.

HEALER / READER BOOTHS:

- 6' wide x 8' deep = \$165 if payment received by March 15, \$190 if paid after March 15
A massage table will not fit in this booth. One 6' table will be provided. If you want a smaller table inside your booth (to do readings, etc), you must provide your own. Also, a 6 foot table will fit across the entire front of the booth – therefore, if you want the public to enter your booth, the table must sit sideways inside the booth, or you need to bring your own, smaller table to go across the front of the booth or you need to order a larger booth.

1. Set up time to be announced. Fest hours are 10am to 6pm.
2. Only products and services listed above are to be sold at this Festival.
3. Sponsors reserve the right to determine products and services offered. Every attempt is made to diversify the Festival.
4. Participants are responsible to meet city & state licensing laws.
5. Sharing and sub-letting of booths is not permitted.
6. Flyers & samples etc. must be limited to Participants' booths – you may not leave your booth to pass out flyers.
7. Vendor booths are 6' X 8' or 8' x 8'.
 - a. Each booth has 2 chairs provided.
 - b. Booths have one 6 ft x 24 inch or 8 ft x 24 inch non-draped table provided. Exhibitors may bring own tables.
 - c. Premium booths have two 8' tables provided.
 - d. 2 exhibitor passes included with each booth.
8. Space will be reserved upon receipt of application, contract, and non-refundable **deposit of \$100.**
 - a. **Final payment for the booth is due no later than March 15. Failure to meet this deadline could result in cancellation of booth. Only one notice will be given before rights to booth will be relinquished.**
 - b. **Cancellation with less than 14 days notice results in \$100 non-refund of booth fee.**
 - c. **Cancellation with less than 7 days notice results in total non-refund of booth fee.**
9. Sponsors not responsible for loss, breakage, or theft of Participants merchandise or belongings.
10. **Participants are required to hold the booth open for the entire Festival – if you leave early you will not be invited to participate in another Fest.**
11. Booths should be prepared and ready for the public 15 minutes prior to opening.
12. Any other areas not covered are to be discussed with the sponsors prior to the Event.
13. In the event that any outside force, beyond the control of the Sponsor (environmental, etc.) prevents the Festival from taking place or the Booth Participant from attending, Sponsors reserve the right to retain payments for expense compensation.
